January 26, 2024 (Washington, DC) The Women's Fiction Writers Association (WFWA) is excited to announce award-winning novelist and historical women's fiction author, Denny S. Bryce as the association's 2024 Guiding Scribe.

Denny is the bestselling author of: *The Other Princess: A Novel of Queen Victoria's Goddaughter*, *A Face in the Sun*, and *Wild Women and the Blue*, and upcoming 2024 releases *Can't We Be Friends: A Novel of Ella Fitzgerald and Marilyn Monroe* (co-authored with Eliza Knight) and *The Trial of Mrs. Rhineland*. A longtime member of the Women's Fiction Writers Association, she is also a member of the Historical Novel Society, and Tall Poppy Writers.

"The Guiding Scribe is an important resource and scholar for our organization, akin to a poet laureate," says Kristi Leonard, WFWA President. "Denny is a prolific historical women's fiction author who is writing immersive, richly told stories with African American and Black female protagonists set in the 19th and early-to-mid 20th centuries. Her level of craft and generosity in sharing her skills as a mentor will inspire us to tell our authentic stories."

A 20-year marketing and public relations professional, Denny is also an NPR book critic, an adjunct professor at Drexel University, and a freelance writer who has written for *Harper's Bazaar* and *USA Today*.

"The Women's Fiction Writers Association is a vibrant community of women's fiction writers. I'm looking forward to sharing some of the highlights of my experiences in publishing and to connecting with the membership at a larger level," says Bryce.
